Who is WaterAid?

WaterAid is an international not-for-profit, determined to make clean water, decent toilets and good hygiene normal for everyone, everywhere within a generation.

Can I pay via direct debit?

Who is organising this event?

What sort of event is it?

What time does the Ball start and end?

6.30pm till 11.30pm, Saturday 24 July 2021.

What happens on the night?

During the night there will be lots of fundraising activities including a raffle, silent auction, live auction, wine wall and entertainment for you to relax and enjoy. We will only accept credit card payments.

Will I receive tickets for the night?

All tickets will be electronically issued. These will help you know where to go, what time etc and are ideal for sending on to your guests.

Why do I need to provide the names of my guests in advance?

For COVID-19 government safety regulations we must have your guests full name, organisation, email and phone number to provide to the venue for contract tracing purposes. We will also have an electronic bidding system on the night – and for this to work, we need to have the names of your guests in advance. Without guest names you will not receive electronic bidding for your table. It also helps us with any guests with dietary requirements.
